New Jersey Register Ready

It is important to be prepared in case of a disaster.

Register Ready is a program that helps emergency responders and other safety professionals plan and prepare to support New Jersey residents in a disaster or other emergency.

People in New Jersey who have disabilities or access and functional needs, their families, friends, and caregivers, can share information about their safety needs and concerns with Register Ready, by completing an online form.

The information is used to help with emergency planning and response. The information you provide remains private and is only used by Emergency Planning Professionals, like police, fire safety professionals, etc. The information is not available to the public. This information can help emergency responders better plan to serve you in a disaster or other emergency.

To register for Register Ready:

3. Enter information about yourself in the form.
