- 2. Tell me about yourself.
- 3. Why did you select JCMC, MMC, NBI or SBMC for your residency?
- 4. What have you learned during your residency? *Or* what was your experience during your residency?
- 5. Why do you want this fellowship?
- 6. What are your medical goals?
- 7. What would you consider to be your perfect job?
- 8. What two or three things are most important to you in your job?
- 9. What accomplishments have given you the most satisfaction? Why?
- 10. What would you want me to know that is not on your CV?

MORE INTERVIEW TIPS

- o Show up on time!
- Be prepared to explain gaps on your CV.
- o Do your homework! Don't skimp on pre-interview research.
- o If you included something in your written application, be prepared to speak about it.
- o You are always interviewing! Be polite and respectful to everyone you meet.
- o Be yourself. Be honest.
- Social Media is fair game. Keep your online presentation as professional as your appearance in the interview.
