- Must have valid NJ Pharmacy License by September 15th

Graduation Requirements

- Resident must have achieved 90% of the objectives set forth by the program
- Resident must have achieved all goals in R1: Patient Care
- Resident must complete a research project and a manuscript which can be submitted to a peer reviewed journal
- Resident must present a poster at ASHP Midyear Clinical Meeting
- Resident must present platform or poster at annual Eastern States Conference
