

Newark Strong: The Largest Investment in Newark's South Ward in a Generation

Thanks in part to philanthropic giving, Newark Beth Israel Medical Center has embarked on a visionary \$150 milliondollar construction project. This historic renovation will expand our ability to deliver world-class health care to our patients, further enlarge our role as an economic driver in the city of Newark, and transform the landscape of Lyons Avenue.

DELIVERING WORLD-CLASS HEALTH CARE

- Emergency Department: the redesigned Emergency Department will increase patient treatment spaces from 56 to 71, which will improve triage capacity and provide a more welcoming atmosphere for the 95,000 patients treated annually. Additionally, the expansion will allow care teams to operate more effectively with increased focus on patient care.
- Intensive Care Unit: designed with families in mind, a state-of-the-art Intensive Care Unit featuring 13 new, larger rooms will enable loved ones to share in the care and healing of critically ill patients.
- · Geriatric Medical-Surgical Unit: to accommodate the special needs of our elderly patients, two entire floors were transformed into a single comprehensive unit of 24 private rooms. Each unit is outfitted with cushioned flooring, larger signage, family visitor lounges designed to accommodate wheelchairs and specially programmed elevators to keep patients safe on each floor.
- Cardiac Catherization Lab: NBIMC's superior cardiac services make us a top destination nationally for specialized cardiac care; from routine cardiovascular services, to the second largest transplantation program in the country. The expansion of the Catherization Laboratory will add a sixth catherization room, a new hybrid operating room, and upgraded equipment.

TRANSFORMING LYONS AVENUE

A new 17,000 square-foot glass-enclosed lobby will be the visual representation of The Beth's vibrant relationship with the community. This signature element of the Newark Beth Israel Medical Center campus will welcome local residents and groups in community gathering and conference spaces; as well as provide two separate entrances with new patient drop-off areas, a new registration suite and a café.
