Enhanced Emergency Medicine Services

Monmouth Medical Center, Southern Campus routinely ranks among the top 5 percent in New Jersey and top 10 percent in the nation in patient satisfaction. That level of excellence will remain as well as the Emergency Department's status as a 24/7 operation.

The hospital opened in January 2014 a Geriatric Emergency Medicine (GEM) Unit in collaboration with Monmouth Medical Center to better address the emergent health care needs of our aging population. Rather than simply address the emergency medical crisis, our multi-disciplinary team will search for underlying issues that may have caused the health problem.

The GEM unit was specially designed away from the main Emergency Department to provide our aging patients with a quieter, more comfortable environment.

The hospital's Pediatric Emergency Services, a collaboration with The Unterberg Children's Hospital at Monmouth Medical Center, will remain with 24/7 access to pediatric consultants at the Children's Hospital.
