Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital Somerset is a nationally accredited, 341-bed hospital in Somerville, New Jersey, providing comprehensive emergency, medical/surgical and rehabilitative services.

The hospital is honored as a leader in LGBT Healthcare Equality by the Human Rights Campaign.

The hospital is also nationally recognized as a Magnet® hospital for nursing excellence. The Steeplechase Cancer Center at Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital Somerset has been honored with the prestigious Outstanding Achievement Award from the Commission on Cancer of the American College of Surgeons. The hospital is also distinguished for its Joint Surgery Institute, receiving the Joint Commission's Gold Seal of Approval for total knee and total hip replacement surgery, and is designated as a Primary Stroke Center by the Joint Commission and the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services. In addition, it has received the Joint Commission's Gold Seal of Approval for its acute myocardial infarction program.

A teaching hospital affiliated with Rutgers Robert Wood Johnson Medical School, the hospital maintains a family medicine residency program with 21 residents. Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital Somerset also offers outpatient services at convenient locations in Central New Jersey, including the Sports Physical Therapy and Performance Center in Bridgewater, laboratory services in Bridgewater and Hillsborough, physical therapy services in Hillsborough, Princeton and Flemington and an urgent care center in Hillsborough. In addition, the hospital's affiliated physician practices provide care for families throughout its community.

PROUD Family Health

Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital Somerset is the first hospital in New Jersey to offer specialized primary care services for the LGBTQIA community at our PROUD Family Health. We are committed to providing a safe and supportive environment where you can get the medical care you need at all stages of your life.

Our services include:

- Primary medical care
- Hormone therapy and monitoring
- HIV Prevention (PrEP)
- Referrals for specialty services, such as behavioral health services
- Health education and counseling
- A monthly support group for family members of transgender individuals

PROUD Family Health is located on the hospital's campus, offering patients access to our comprehensive health care services such as emergency, laboratory, radiology, cardiology, behavioral health, oncology and rehabilitation services and an on-site Walgreen's pharmacy.

As part of RWJBarnabas Health, our patients also have access to a wide range of specialists and services offered through our network of 11 hospitals, including gender confirming surgery.

Our Health Care Team

Our health care team recognizes the unique medical needs of the LGBTQIA community and is dedicated to offering high-quality, culturally competent care. Our team includes physicians, nurses and a patient navigator, who helps guide patients and their families through the health care system.

PROUD Family Health is located in a dedicated, modern medical suite adjacent to our Somerset Family Practice. Our facility is conveniently located in Central New Jersey and is easily accessible from most major highways, including Routes 287, 78, 202 and 206, the Garden State Parkway and the New Jersey Turnpike.

Free parking is available in a surface lot adjacent to our center. The center is handicapped accessible.
