

With your safety and comfort in mind, we are hosting this year's event outdoors at Brick Farm Tavern.

There will also be a virtual experience for those who choose not to attend in person.

What are the COVID-19 guidelines and policies in place for this in-person event?

We vs. C The Tree of Life will take place entirely outdoors at Brick Farm Tavern.

We are mindful of the current Executive Order and will be releasing in-person event tickets on a first-come first-serve basis as we progress through this environment. We will notify you of your ticket status no later than June 7, 2021.

- ♦ Temperature check, symptom screening, travel and exposure screening will occur upon arrival.
 - Individuals with a temperature over 100 degrees or answer "yes" to any symptom or screening questions will not be allowed entrance.
- All guests must be masked at all times except when eating or drinking.
- ♦ All eating and drinking must occur while seated at a table or in designated areas in accordance with social distancing guidelines
- Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the event.

Is there a virtual experience for this event?

Yes, all guests will have the option to purchase an event ticket to attend the event or an event ticket to experience the event virtually at a later date.

♦ All virtual tickets will include a gift bag with items, including a gift card to Brick Farm Tavern, to celebrate the event that will be delivered to them the week after our in-person event that will include a link to view the event.

Is this event weather permitting?

No, this event will occur rain or shine. While the event is completely outdoors, there are tenting protocols in place to comfortably shield guests from the rain/elements.

Can I switch my ticket from "in-person" ticket to a "virtual" ticket, or vice versa?

Yes, initially, you must select which ticket option you want upon purchase of your ticket. Should you, for any reason, need to change your ticket type, you will have until June 4th to do so by contacting the Foundation Office at 609.249.7527. *Please remember the number of in-person attendees will be limited based on the Governor's Executive Order at the time.















What is the registration process?

Once guests arrive, there will be valet parking and a self park option. There will be two registration lines (divided alphabetically by last name) to avoid congestion.

At registration, temperature check, symptom and travel screenings will take place. Event navigators will be on site to direct attendees.

Will there be valet parking?

Yes. All valets will be wearing protective safety gear, including face masks, at all times. Valet podium is stocked with sanitizing wipes which will be used to disinfect ALL contact points inside and outside of the vehicle before the guest returns to retrieve it. Valet intake and outtake uses a ticketless valet system called OBEE. You may also choose to self park on the venue grounds guided by the valet team.

Will I be able to purchase a ticket at the door?

Unfortunately, we will not be able to accommodate tickets at the door. All tickets will be pre-sold and event registration ends on Friday, June 4th.

Will there be assigned seating?

No; there will be comfortable seating for every individual at the event and we encourage our guests to take part in the many entertaining aspects of the event we have planned. Please note that these stations have been designed with safety protocols while maintaining guest comfort and enjoyment.

What is the dress attire?

Fancy Ranch! This means you should "dress to impress," but consider the environment when you select your outfit. Female guests could wear flowing summer dresses/skirts and comfortable flats, chunky heels or wedges when walking the grounds. Male guests can opt for light colored linen and/or business casual or dressy jeans (no ripped or torn denim please). Please no suit and ties!

Will there be a raffle or silent auction?

Yes, the event will offer a seasonal-designed basket raffle (Spring, Summer, Fall & Winter) with a minimum value of \$500.00 each, along with a \$3,000-valued grand prize raffle.
