**The Hirair and Anna Hovnanian Emergency Pavilion at Community Medical Center (CMC)** is one of the busiest in New Jersey – treating life’s minor injuries and more serious illnesses. CMC is currently renovating the Emergency Department (ED) to ensure every patient receives the prompt, exceptional care they need. The new ED will funnel both ambulance and ambulatory patients to the same entry point, ensuring all patients are uniformly triaged at intake. Often, the sickest patients do not necessarily arrive by ambulance, so this approach is critical for treatment. Access to state-of-the-art diagnostic equipment will be much more efficient. With a large local geriatric population, it is important to rule out a risk of stroke for an incoming patient, so CT scans will be placed with easy access from the new ED, allowing for patients needing immediate interventions to be treated quickly. Designed with an understanding of the needs and demographics of the Ocean County community, the new ED will be geriatric and family friendly. Constructed with sound absorbing materials, soothing colors and equipment placement to accommodate limited mobility, the ED will be more accessible to patients who are already stressed. We are ready and able to handle all of life’s emergencies. **Community Medical Center is able to provide the highest level of care, thanks, in part, to donors like you.**

## H. HOVNIANIAN FAMILY FOUNDATION SUPPORTS FUTURE OF COMMUNITY MEDICAL CENTER


