Signing into 3M

Physicians sign into 3M with their assigned ID number.

This same number will used for dictation.

Depending on where you are signing in from, you will see one of these log-in screens:






When signing into 3M, the first place you'll be brought to is your signature list. Here, you may sign and/or edit dictated reports and finalize.

Orders that have been created in Cerner, but not signed in Cerner prior to discharge, will also be included in this list for you to sign. To avoid having to sign Cerner orders in 3M, sign your reports in Cerner at the time you have documented. Don't wait!

Power notes created in Cerner do not merge to 3M until signed and finalized in Cerner. You cannot sign these in 3M nor will they be in the patient's 3M chart – the legal medical record.



Points to Remember

- What you do in Cerner, sign in Cerner at the time of documentation, if possible.
- ❖ If you use dictation, please sign the report in 3M Not Cerner.
- Sign into 3M at least once a week to keep up with anything that needs to be signed, dictated, or edited. This will keep you from having delinquent charts.
