As you are aware, the incidence of COVID-19 is increasing in our community. The Transitional Care Unit (TCU) at Community Medical Center provides a short-term, sub-acute level of care and is committed to providing a safe environment for our residents, families, visitors and staff.

In an effort to keep everyone safe, we continue to follow the NJDOH executive directive (s) and CDC guidelines for restricting visitors. At this time visitation is restricted with the exception of End – of life, certain compassionate care and essential care giver in designated areas. All new admissions to the TCU are required to quarantine, and be placed on precautionary isolation throughout their stay on the TCU.

Please know that all our residents receive a COVID -19 Test upon admission and our staff is tested weekly.

I apologize if these restrictions create an inconvenience, but safety is our priority.
