














Our Vision, Mission and Values

We funded new technologies including online scheduling and our new Patient Family Portal which gives families the ability to refill medications online. And, we extended our partnership with the Kessler Foundation for another three years, enabling our teams to continue important research investigating ways to improve mobility, cognition and educational outcomes in children with various challenges.

Thanks to continuous support of donors like you, through hours of volunteer service and leadership, as well as financial contributions, you have directly impacted Children's Specialized Hospital, allowing us to expand our services, complete renovations and purchase new equipment, all helping us reach our shared goal of transforming the lives of the children we serve.

Burton, a 24-month-old golden retriever, is now a full-time employee of Children's Specialized Hospital in New Brunswick.

34,000 patients served

In 2017, Children's Specialized Hospital saw a record 11% increase in the number of patients treated. Additionally, we welcomed 13 new doctors and advance practice nurses to the team to support this growth, which also allowed us, in just two years, to help decrease the wait time by 40 days.

Holiday radiothons to raise awareness and funds

The 2017 holiday season saw three successful Radiothons on behalf of Children's Specialized Hospital. 95.5 WPLJ-FM, 94.7 NASH-FM and 92.7 WOBM collectively raised over \$120,000 to support our kids with special health care needs.

Using telecommunication technology, telepsychiatry enables clinicians to provide psychiatric assessment and care remotely. Thanks to a grant by The Provident Bank, the innovative telepsychiatry initiative is helping families and clinicians revolutionize the way children receive essential medical services.

Transforming lives through

discovery...

On the second day of 6th grade, New Mexico resident, Christopher Lueras was not feeling like himself. His family disregarded it thinking he was a typical middle schooler trying to get a day off from school, until he collapsed with shooting pains in his right side while filling his water bottle.

Rushed to the hospital and treated for gastrointestinal issues, Christopher's doctors assured the Lueras family he had severe constipation that would pass with medication and sent him home. But when he returned to the emergency room two days later, they had no idea what was ahead of them.

Christopher spent six weeks in the hospital undergoing test after test. Thirteen diagnoses later, they were no closer to uncovering what was going on inside of him, which now took control over his body and prohibited him from moving his right leg. His skin became so sensitive that he could not bear clothes, covers or being hugged by his own mother. The breeze that came through when the doctors opened his hospital door would send him into excruciating pain.

What could cause a happy, healthy, athletic young kid this much pain? Amplified Musculoskeletal Pain Syndrome (AMPS), a chronic pain condition in which the abnormal pain reflex constricts the blood vessels. This restricts blood flow and oxygen from the muscles, bones and skin resulting in an acid build-up that causes a child amplified pain. "Chronic pain syndromes are often misdiagnosed because though the child has pain and dysfunction, most of the medical tests come back normal," said Dr. Katherine Bentley, Director of the Chronic Pain Management Program at Children's Specialized.

Forced to miss school and extracurricular activities due to the pain of AMPS, Christopher spiraled into a depression. It became so bad that he created a fort out of cardboard boxes where he chose to live for two weeks straight just so that his family would not have to see him in pain. They tried acupuncture, medical hypnosis, physical therapy, water therapy, salt baths and more but nothing seemed to help. Over 275 unproductive therapy sessions later, Diane brought Christopher over 1,980 miles across the country to Children's Specialized Hospital in New Brunswick, New Jersey.

"I was honestly amazed. We accomplished more in the first few days at Children's Specialized than we had been able to in the 275 appointments back home," said Diane.


Christopher spent four weeks in the Chronic Pain Management Program at Children's Specialized. As one of the few inpatient pain programs in the country, this multidisciplinary approach for adolescents focuses on improving function and reintegrating the child back into their everyday life. Through occupational, physical, aquatic and psychological therapies, Chris worked eight hours a day, seven days a week to regain his strength. He came into the hospital confined to a wheelchair, and left walking. "Towards the end of his stay, we would get in trouble for running up and down the hall but I didn't care because I got my little brother back," said Christopher's sister Savannah.

With a toolkit of skills he learned at Children's Specialized Hospital, Christopher is now able to manage his flare-ups at home and is back to doing the things he loves like rock climbing and hiking. While on a three-day hiking trip with his friends, he began to experience some pain in his legs. "I immediately sat down, took some deep breaths and was back on the trail in a few minutes," remembers Christopher.

"I feel like I've gotten my life back completely. It's really just a miracle," says Christopher.

Our evidence-based Chronic Illness and Chronic Pain Management Programs serve adolescents and young adults ages 11-21 years old by teaching strategies to manage pain and encourage functional activity. Our approach includes intense physical and occupational therapies, as well as integrated mental health intervention.

Transforming lives through technology...

From PS4 to poker on your phone, classic board games to playing H-O-R-S-E in your driveway, Extra Life gamers unite across the world to play games in support of their local Children's Miracle Network Hospital. Since its inception in 2008, Extra Life has raised more than \$40 million nationally for children facing devastating illness and/or injury.

Children's Specialized Hospital, a local member of the Children's Miracle Network Hospitals, works with the New Jersey Extra Life Guild, a passionate group of gamers who are eager to make an impact for the kids. Brian Remite, President of the New Jersey Guild, works to strengthen the Extra Life community by finding new ways to grow the Extra Life movement, hosting fundraising events throughout the year, and participating in gaming industry events and conferences like New York Comic Con. In 2017, local Extra Life gamers participated in a 24-hour gaming marathon that helped raise a record-breaking \$177,000 in support of Children's Specialized Hospital.

Thanks to their generous gift, we were able to help transform the lives of our patients and clinicians at our Mountainside, New Jersey site through the launch of the Vocera Communication Platform, a voice system that promotes seamless, secure communication in real time.











Game-Changing Communication

The Vocera system revolutionizes the way our clinicians communicate. Day-in and day-out health care providers rely on the ability to communicate with one another in order to deliver the highest quality care to our patients. Vocera enables communication via a special badge that can be clipped to clothing or worn around the neck, leaving hands free. Messages are broadcast to either one person or the entire team by speaking into the microphone and informing the system to whom you want your message to go. The connection is instant and the communication clear—no more looking at phones or listening to the intercom. Clinicians can say a person's name or department and are instantly connected.

The impact of this technology is tremendous. When healthcare communication between members of the team breaks down, inefficiencies can arise that may adversely affect patient outcomes. Vocera unifies staff members who may not work side-by-side, or even in the same building, allowing them to discuss patient medical histories and treatment. Decreasing response time between health care providers leads to enhanced care coordination and patient safety.

In addition to being used at our New Brunswick site, Children's Specialized Hospital implemented Vocera in Mountainside this February. Not only are our clinicians enjoying the technology and its positive impact on our care, but other members of our staff—from our therapists to our environmental employees—are finding it very helpful as well.

Recently recognized as Distinguished Individual honorees at the Foundation's 30th Annual Umbrella Gala for their longstanding commitment to our hospital, Fran and Nick, like any good superheroes, deflected the accolades and requested we take the opportunity to recognize their

> heroes, the children who live in our Long Term Care Unit, and the staff who work tirelessly and selflessly to care for them.

Thanks to the generous gala contributions in tribute of Fran and Nick's service, Children's Specialized will be able to take infection prevention to the next level. Through the purchase of an important piece of equipment—the Hubscrub—our patients in Long Term Care, many of whom are too medically fragile to be cared for at home or in other community settings, will benefit from clean, sanitized equipment. The Hubscrub ensures that wheelchairs, walkers, car seats and more are meticulously cleaned to the Hospital's high standards in only six minutes using disinfectant and UV lights. This powerful piece of equipment will help safeguard the immune systems of our most vulnerable population.



Thanks to trained volunteers like Eddie DeStefanis (pictured above), children and teens with special health care needs can participate in age-appropriate activities through our Activity Connection programs at Children's Specialized Hospital. Programs include recreation, sports and social activities which are led by Children's Specialized's therapists, certified instructors, coaches and volunteers. The programs provide opportunities to make new friends, participate in physical activities and enjoy new experiences.

With your help, our Activity Connection programs saw a 46% increase in registration.

To meet growing demand, the program hired two new staff members to help coordinate activities and now offers adaptive aquatics in three sites, in addition to adding yoga and teen social programs to serve over 525 children and adolescents last year.

Eddie has donated a total of 1,725 hours of service over 12 years through programs such as adaptive aquatics, martials arts, Friday Night Fever and Teen Night. Dedication such as his has a transformative power on the lives, health and well-being of our children and families.




Foundation Revenue
