Title: Use of Low-Cost Orthotic Device to Improve Upper Extremity Function in Children with Cerebral Palsy

- Does your child have cerebral palsy or right or left arm hemiplegia?
- Does your child have a hard time using one of their hands?
- Is your child between 4 and 17 years of age?

If you answered yes to all of these, your child may qualify for an investigational study about a unique approach to treatment of their hand.

This investigational study will test the use of a 3 D printed brace sized and fabricated with an Occupational therapist, which will use arm motion to assist with finger opening combined with Occupational therapy treatment verses Occupational therapy treatment alone. Participants will be assigned to either group by chance in a randomized process.

If your child qualifies for the study, all services will be provided free of charge.
