An egg hunt is a game. Some egg hunts are outside and others are inside.

Lots of colored plastic eggs are placed around in a certain area.



I can bring a bag, bucket, or basket to the egg hunt.

During the egg hunt, it is helpful to put the eggs I collect into my bag, bucket, or basket.



During the egg hunt, I look for eggs. Some may be hidden around the area.

When I am told to start, I walk into the area with the plastic eggs. I don't run or push others in the area.

When I find an egg, I pick it up and put it into my bag, basket, or bucket.There are many eggs to choose from. These eggs are for everyone to share.I make sure I don't take too many eggs so everyone can have some.



At the end of the egg hunt, I show the eggs I found to my family or friends. If a person didn't find an egg, I can give the person one of my eggs. Inside the plastic eggs, there may be prizes, chocolate, or candy. I carefully open the egg with my family or friends to see what is inside. I can color these eggs to remind me about the egg hunt.
