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PerformCare is the agency contracted through the New Jersey Children's System of Care for children and teens up to age 21 with behavioral or mental health, intellectual or developmental disabilities, or substance abuse issues from which they can obtain publically available services. Services include mobile crisis, in-home or community support, respite, assistive technology, help with camps, and case management. PerformCare is also the agency that determines eligibility for developmental disability services for children under age 18.

New Jersey Special Child Health Services


With parent consent case managers work with the child's parents, physician, and/or specialists to evaluate the child's strengths and needs. They collaborate with the family and community-based partners to develop an individual service plan (ISP) for the child and family. Case managers are provided through county offices. New Jersey Special Child Health Services is operated through the NJ Department of Health.

PerformCare

Helping families across New Jersey

PerformCare is the single point of entry for the New Jersey Children's System of Care (CSOC). Help is available for children, adolescents and young adults (up to age 21) seeking behavioral health, intellectual/developmental disability, or certain substance use treatment services.

Available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week — 1-877-652-7624

Families should call if their child's behavior has changed or if they are overwhelmed by challenges at home or in the community. Some common reasons to call PerformCare include:

- Depression and/or anxiety.
- Bullying or being bullied.
- Physical or verbal aggression.
- Intellectual/developmental disabilities.
- · Substance use.
- · Inattention or hyperactivity.
- Oppositional or defiant behavior.
- · Grief from major trauma.
- Concerns from teachers.

No matter what the challenge, the Children's System of Care can help put your child on the path to a better quality of life. Depending on your child's needs, CSOC services include:

- Referral to counseling services.
- Mobile response to stabilize crisis situations.
- Care management for intense and complex needs.
- Assessments to determine your child's needs.
- Behavioral supports for activities of daily living.
- Family support for education and advocacy.
- Respite services for families.
- Substance use treatment (up to age 18).



SCHS Case Managers, with parental consent, work with the child's parents and the physician to evaluate an affected child's strengths and needs; and develops an individual service plan for the child and family. Medical, educational, developmental, social and economic needs of the child and family are targeted.

You're caring for your special needs child...Who is caring for you?

At Mom 2 Mom our focus is caring for you....

Mothers with special needs children are at risk for depression and related disorders (Reuters, 4/18/2008). Studies show parents of special needs children have significantly higher divorce rates than those with typically developing children. Medical illness, financial stressors, faith based issues, and employment struggles often accompany the challenges of being a primary caregiver of a special needs child.

When you become a mother it is often a miraculous experience in your life.

When your child is identified as having special needs, it is potentially the most devastating experience of your life.

As the primary caregiver mothers try to "fix" everything for their child. Some challenges cannot be fixed, but rather adapted to. The "MOM 2 MOM" Peer Support Helpline Program answers the need.

An abundance of resources for children with special needs have been established with a focus on advocacy, education, and financial support for those loved ones.

The missing link however has been the recognition for the needed services for the primary caregiver's mental health and wellness, specifically a service for mothers.

By dialing **1-877-914- MOM2** (1-877-914-6662) **MOM 2 MOM** helpline program a mother of a child with special needs will receive the following services:

Mom 2 Mom Peer Support- M2M Peer Supporters will be available to provide telephone peer support to callers in need. Moms of special needs children trained in peer counseling and crisis support will offer peer support, explain resources, and explore your needs. Mom 2 Mom peer support is also available through our website for a live chat experience online.

<u>Mom 2 Mom Clinical Assessment</u> -M2M Clinicians will be on the helpline as part of the team of clinical professionals available to do telephonic assessment and gage the depression, anxiety, and family & marital issues, etc. that may be impacting your life.

<u>Mom 2 Mom Network</u>- A M2M database of specially trained service providers will be available for referrals for your mental health needs.

MOM 2 MOM Support Groups- Within your communities Mom Peer Supporters will be available every month for Mom 2 Mom support groups.
