



My Child's IEP Development Checklist



1

My child has developmental delays or is struggling in school

2

A referral for evaluation is submitted to determine the need for special education services

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My child's school district conducts comprehensive evaluations in areas of need

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If I disagree with an evaluation, I can request an independent evaluation and/or pay for my own evaluation

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If the evaluations indicate my child's disabilities affect education, my child may be determined eligible for an IEP

6

Upon eligibility, I work with my child's special education team to develop the PLAAFP and IEP goals along with appropriate modifications, accommodations, and related services

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Once the IEP has been written, the school district will work with me to decide my child's placement

8

Each year, the special education team reviews the IEP goals and services to address my child's progress, conduct necessary evaluations, and revise the IEP as needed

9

IEP re-evaluations occur at least every three years (but not more than once a year)

10

I can request an IEP review meeting in writing at any time
