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Dual Training: Suicide Safety for Teachers and School Staff (SSTSS) & Awareness, Interaction, Direction (A.I.D.)

The SSTSS training is designed to meet the basic needs of school administration, faculty, and staff. Emphasis is on recognizing warning signs, clarifying the referral process in place at school, and making a warm handoff.

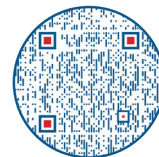
A.I.D. teaches participants how to interact effectively with someone experiencing mental distress. Participants will be able to recognize signs and symptoms of distress, effectively interact with someone in distress, and be able to locate and provide resources to individuals in distress.
