Employee Campaign

Each year, the RWJBarnabas Health System holds their Annual Employee Campaign. This campaign offers the opportunity for employees to make donations to the hospital in support of their fellow employees. In 2025, the JCMC Employee Campaign raised more than **\$50,000** in support of the:

A huge thank you to our Hudson County community who supported our Hudson Gives Campaign. This online fundraising campaign unites the community to support Hudson County Nonprofits. This year's campaign focused on our Patient Assistance Fund, specifically raising funds for patient comfort kits for our adult behavioral health patients and our patients in the Emergency Department.

With the generous support from our community and partners, we were able to raise **\$10,895**.

On Tuesday, October 28th, hospital staff and community volunteers came together in the spirit of kindness and teamwork to pack more than 500 comfort kits for our patients in the Emergency Department. Each kit was filled with thoughtful items meant to bring a little comfort and care to patients during a stressful time. It was a wonderful day of connection and generosity, showing how much our community truly cares for one another. This effort was made possible through the incredible generosity of our Hudson Gives donors.



Supporting our Doctors of Tomorrow

With the support of our community, and a generous contribution from the Medical and Dental Staff at Jersey City Medical Center, the \$2.4 million renovation of the Medical Center's Graduate Medical Education facilities enhanced its academic infrastructure and capabilities. 
Our community came together to support Jersey City Medical Center, here are some highlights from 2025:

67th Hudson County STEM Showcase


