A medical oncologist and nurse practitioner will guide this discussion and answer questions. A certified oncology nurse navigator will review the importance of health maintenance and share key reminders for survivors.
Nutrition Post-Treatment	Tuesday, December 8, 2026 5:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.	When transiting from treatment to survivorship, your body may experience changes in nutritional needs. A registered dietitian will provide an overview of basic nutritional information and share tips on how to review nutritional information, cooking, and shopping so that you can best fuel your body.
Coping with the Fear of Recurrence	Tuesday, March 9, 2027 4:30 p.m. - 5:30 p.m.	Learn about coping with the fear of cancer recurrence. A licensed oncology social worker will discuss how common this concern is and share information about resources available to survivors.
