Monmouth Medical Center remains committed to the City of Long Branch, with plans for expansive renovations and redesign to create a 345,000-square-foot facility featuring tranquil green spaces and ample parking for patients, visitors, and staff.

Centralized services and optimized space utilization will enhance the patient experience, support workflow efficiency, and improve staff satisfaction.



- Providing essential health services for patients, including emergency, behavioral, imaging and more.
- Renovations of the main patient care tower and an updated façade
- Transition to **100% private patient rooms** throughout the facility for increased comfort, privacy, and optimal healing.
- A new psychiatric facility, developed in partnership with Rutgers University
 Behavioral Health Care and RWJBarnabas Health, will provide 63 behavioral health inpatient beds and outpatient services in a holistic, healing environment.
- The full-service **Emergency Department** will remain a critical resource for the community, delivering timely, high-quality emergency care.
- An observation unit with **24 state-of-the-art acuity adaptable beds** will improve patient flow and allow for flexible care.
- Outpatient surgery for adult and pediatric patients will be offered at the Cranmer Ambulatory Surgery Center, conveniently located off the Main Lobby.
- Specialty medical and surgical clinics will provide expanded access to advanced care close to home.
- State-of-the-art imaging services, including **mammography**, will continue to support high-quality diagnostics.



- The modernization builds on more than \$35 million invested in Monmouth Medical Center over the past decade, reinforcing its role as a trusted health care anchor for Long Branch and surrounding communities.
- Rideshare partnerships will ensure transportation for patients in need, maintaining equitable access to care at both Long Branch and the new Tinton Falls campus.
