The Jacqueline M. Wilentz Breast Center at Monmouth Medical Center, Southern Campus offers Ocean County residents convenient access to Monmouth Medical Center's renowned breast health services in Lakewood.

Our facility, located in the main hospital next to Outpatient Services, offers breast screening mammography, diagnostic mammography, breast surgery consultation and high risk cancer assessment. All imaging exams conducted at our location are performed by experienced, certified mammography technologists and interpreted by dedicated breast imaging physicians.

MMCSC also has a fellowship trained breast surgeon onsite for breast surgical and high risk cancer assessment consultations. Fellowship trained breast surgeons are general surgeons who have completed five to seven years of general surgery after medical school who continue for additional advanced and extensive surgical training and education specifically in breast disease and surround lymph nodes, diagnosis and treatment. Fellowship trained breast surgeons are also knowledgeable in techniques that optimize the best potential cosmetic outcome. They exhibit competency in Breast Imaging, Breast Surgery, Genetics, Medical Oncology, Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery, Radiation Oncology, Psychosocial and Social Oncology, as well as Community Service and Outreach.

What We Offer

Our state-of-the-art facility offers the latest in medical equipment, technology and services, including:

Breast Screening Mammography

For patients with no abnormal breast symptoms, a breast screening mammogram offers the best opportunity for early detection of breast cancer. The procedure takes approximately 15 minutes and most screening mammograms do not require a physician order. Once a baseline is established, future mammograms are compared to detect changes through the aging process.

Diagnostic Mammography

Diagnostic Mammograms are tailored to patients with symptoms of benign breast disease or breast cancer, or who are at high risk for breast cancer. The Breast Center's breast imagers specialize in the technical aspects involved in diagnosing breast problems. They are joined by an impressive staff of mammography technologists and nurses – all of whom are sensitive to the needs and concerns of every patient.

Breast Surgery Consultation

At the Jacqueline M. Wilentz Breast Center, Dr. Manpreet Kohli, our fellowship trained breast surgeon sees patients for initial consultations as well as routine follow ups. Dr. Kohli provides thorough and compassionate care for patients who have breast cancer, benign breast lesions, or that may be "high risk" with a strong family history or known genetic mutation predisposing to breast cancer. When treating breast cancer, Dr. Kohli uses her expertise in breast surgical oncology to determine a tailor made plan for each patient along with a multidisciplinary team of breast cancer specialists.

High Risk Cancer Assessment

At registration, mammography patients use a tablet-style computer to check off answers to questions related to breast history and family cancer history. Based on guidelines published by the National Comprehensive Cancer Network, the data gathered helps us estimate each patient's risk of gene mutation as well as lifetime risk of developing breast cancer. Risk assessment reports are then provided to both the patient and the physician.

Diagnostic Ultrasound

A high resolution tool that helps visualize breast tissue that may be difficult to see on a mammogram alone.

Whole Breast Ultrasound

Whole Breast Ultrasound screenings are used in adjunct to a mammogram for screening patients who have dense breast tissue.
