**Laptop requirement for Fall 2024**

Please be advised that as a student in the NURE classes beginning the fall semester 2024/spring 2025, you are required to have a laptop computer with systems requirements noted below so you can:

- access all course material from anywhere.
- submit clinical and class assignments.
- Take course exams administered with Examsoft software, ***Exemplify***.

Students are strongly encouraged to review the information below to ensure that their laptops meet the requirements for computerized testing.

### **Note:**

- ***Exemplify*** will not run on Chromebooks, Android, or Linux operating systems •

***Exemplify*** does not support touchscreen input on Mac or Windows laptops •

School of Nursing does **NOT** allow the use of an iPad

### **Recommended Requirements for Windows Operating System:**

- Operating System: 64-bit versions of Windows 10 or Windows 11
- CPU Processor: Intel Core i5 or better **or** AMD Ryzen 5 or better

- RAM: 8GB of usable RAM or higher
- Hard drive: 100GB or higher (Program requires a minimum of 4GB or higher of available space)
- 1366x768 Screen resolution with scaling set to 100% (Minimum of 1280 x 768)

**Recommended Requirements for MAC Operating System:**

- Operating System: Mac OSX 12 or higher
- CPU Processor: Apple Series M processor (minimum of Intel)
- RAM: 8GB of usable RAM or higher
- Hard drive: 100GB or higher (Program requires a minimum of 4GB or higher of available space)
- 1366x768 Screen resolution with scaling set to 100% (Minimum of 1280 x 768)
