This program awards a Diploma in Nursing from RWJBarnabas Health School of Nursing and an Associate of Science degree from UCNJ upon successful, 5 semesters and/or 2.5 years, completion of the curriculum. RWJBarnabas Health School of Nursing now has 2 locations - Elizabeth and Oceanport, NJ. The generic RN track is offered at both locations. However, the LPN to RN track is offered at the Elizabeth location.

Our program provides a sound theoretical base of knowledge in nursing, biological, behavioral and social sciences and integrates this knowledge into academic and practical experiences within the health/illness continuum of patient care. The curriculum has many options from which to select in order to complete the program of study.

Steps to Become a Nursing Student

1. Register and attend an online/virtual Information Session.

Note: All applicants must attend one session within 12 months prior to submitting an application. Proof of attendance will be provided and emailed at the end of the session.

2. Laptops are required for electronic exams and quizzes. Purchase and have available at all times a personal laptop computer with minimum systems requirements.

- 3. Apply online to UCNJ Union College of Union County, NJ
- **4.** All prospective students must request and set up a meeting with Academic Advising by email at **nursing@ucc.edu**
- 5. If applicable, request official transcripts from other colleges, universities and institutions and have them sent by email to admissions@ucc.edu for evaluation for transfer of credits. Note, this process may take up to 6 weeks, and transcripts emailed directly by the student cannot be accepted.

- **6.** The following School of Nursing co-requisite courses must be reflected on your UCNJ transcript as either completed, registered for, or currently enrolled:
 - BIO 105 ENG 101 or ENG 112 (non-native English speaking) PSY 101

A minimum grade of "C" or a 70 is required to receive transfer credit for all general education courses.


Note: All potential nursing students who are currently UCNJ students must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 to apply.

7. All new students must take the ATI TEAS Version 7 Exam (online or in-person) and pass with a minimum composite score of 60%. Scores are valid for 2 years and must be sent directly from ATI to RWJBarnabas Health School of Nursing electronically.
