As part of a system-wide initiative to increase access to a comprehensive range of essential cardiac care for residents throughout New Jersey, we have secured approval from the New Jersey Department of Health (NJDOH) to perform elective, or non-emergent, angioplasty procedures. This approval will enable residents of Mercer County and central New Jersey to receive premier quality elective cardiac procedures in a comfortable setting close to home, allowing patients' primary care physicians and cardiologists to participate in care decisions and improve outcomes.

In addition to a renovated facility, the multidisciplinary team at Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital (RWJUH) Hamilton includes nationally-recognized experts in surgical, medical and radiation oncology, as well as oncology-certified nurses, support services team members, and nurse navigators to serve as a resource and to help guide you through your cancer journey. Through our partnership with Rutgers Cancer Institute of New Jersey, the state's only national Cancer Institute (NCI)-designated Comprehensive Cancer Center, Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital Hamilton provides patients access to the most advanced treatment options including complex surgical procedures, clinical trials, precision medicine, immunotherapy, and advanced radiation oncology techniques.
