RWJUH Hamilton, together with Rutgers Cancer Institute, the state's only National Cancer Institute-designated Comprehensive Cancer Center, provides patients access to the most advanced cancer treatments including clinical trials, cellular therapies, complex surgical procedures and sophisticated radiation therapy techniques. RWJUH Hamilton is Joint Commission Certified; designated a Primary Stroke Center by the New Jersey Department of Health and a Center for Excellence by The Joint Commission for stroke, spine surgery and hip and knee replacement; and is MAGNET® Recognized by the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC).

RWJUH Hamilton's other specialties include heart and vascular care, including emergency and elective angioplasty; a heart failure intervention program, coupled with specialty-trained support staff; treatment and care for minor injuries and life-threatening illnesses; outpatient diagnostic and treatment services and medical/surgical services; bariatric surgery; wound care; women's health; geriatrics/senior health and wellness care; infusion services; outpatient rehabilitation and physical therapy centers; including cardiac rehab, pulmonary rehab, orthopedic rehab, speech therapy, aquatic therapy, a balance and hearing center, and sleep center.
