

A UNIQUE PROGRAM

- NJ's FIRST ACS-designated Pediatric Trauma Center.
- Recognized five times as one of "America's Best Children's Hospitals."
- A standalone ED devoted to pediatric emergency medicine.
- Board-certified emergency-medicine physicians present in the department 24-hours-a-day and certified in moderate sedation.
- Nurses specialized in advanced pediatric care.
- No wait, direct bedding and bedside triage and registration.
- Bedside echocardiograms, real-time fluroscopy and EEG's also performed in the ED with no need to move the patient.

FOR REFERRING PHYSICIAN OFFICES

The Pediatric ED offers an office preparedness program where our clinical experts visit physician offices to educate physicians and staff on the appropriate protocol for emergency situations.

- Call ahead service for physicians sending patients.
- Provide communication and feedback to referring physicians for all ED visits.
 - All physicians receive a faxed note alerting them that their patient was in the ED.
