Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital is a dedicated Regional Perinatal Center (RPC) offering the highest level of obstetric and neonatal services in New Jersey. We offer a full range of specialized care including:

- preconception counseling for women on Rx for a chronic condition before pregnancy
- couples with high risk factors for genetic problems before pregnancy
- women with medical problems such as epilepsy, renal transplant, HIV-positive status or cardiovascular disease
- pregnant women with multiples or a previous pre-term infant
- pregnant women for whom a second opinion is desireable

Program Highlights:

- The state's most advanced program for evaluating and preventing pre-term births and pregnancy loss.
- A \$24 million enhancement and renovation of our obstetrical unit to include state-of-the-art maternity care with hotel-like amenities.
 - o 12 labor and delivery rooms
 - o 20 post-partum rooms
 - o 17 ante-partum loft rooms for obstetric emergencies
 - o 4 bed post-anesthesia recovery unit
 - o 3 operating rooms located in 36,000 square feet
 - Maternal-fetal medicine specialists available 24/7 with a multi-D support team.
 - o Newly renovated physician's lounge equipped with:
 - o State-of-the-art central fetal surveillance monitors with remote access from mobile device, office or home.
 - o Expanded nurses' station with a physician dictation area.
