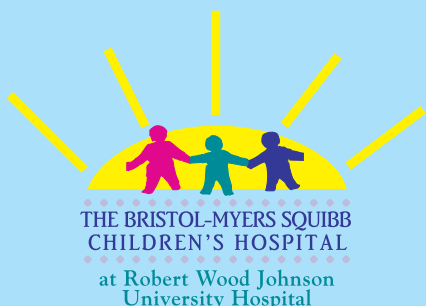
- Four - 600-square-foot operating suites

- Sun room for short-term waiting

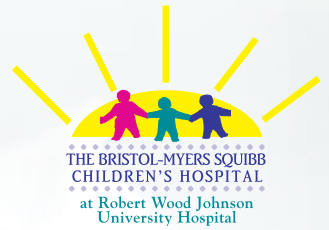
Technology

- Black Diamond Video technology: integrated, ultra-high-definition intra-operative video display, routing and streaming allowing for simultaneous viewing of images and results like X-ray, MRI and EKG as well as room-to-room communication.
- Recovery area where LED lighting systems provide multiple options for comforting, calming or distracting children as they wake up.
- Operating suites fitted with the latest pediatric-specific equipment, including minimally invasive and robotic technology.
