RWJ EMS PROVIDES COMPREHENSIVE CARE IN THE AREAS OF:

- Critical care transport for adults, pediatric & neonate patients
- Basic life support
- Advanced life support
- 911 dispatch center
- EMS and trauma education
- Community outreach & education services
- Injury prevention education
- EMS disaster response

Through the RWJ Health Network, RWJ EMS is licensed by the New Jersey Department of Health's Office of Emergency Medical Service to provide specialty care transport, basic life support and advanced life support. Participating hospitals include:

SPECIALTY CARE TRANSPORT

- Available for all critical or specialty care patient transport needs for all adult patients.
- Equipped to handle long distance transfers as well as complicated patients.
- Vehicles equipped with state-of-the-art electronics, safety, and patient care equipment.
- Transfers between healthcare facilities for patients that require advanced life support or special life sustaining equipment.
- Teams are staffed by NJ state certified or licensed Emergency Medical Technicians, Paramedics, and Critical Care Registered Nurses.
- All paramedics & nurses have a minimum of 2 yrs critical care experience and current ACLS and PALS certifications.
- Capabilities include the management of
 - Ventilators
 - Invasive lines
 - Intra-aortic balloon pumps
 - Ventricular assist systems
 - Intravenous medications & pumps
 - Pressure infusion

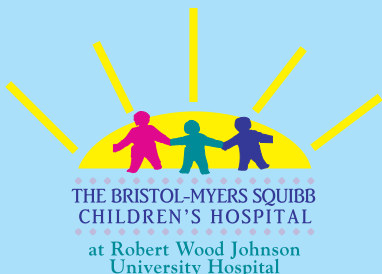


PEDIATRIC TRANSPORT AND OUTREACH

The Pediatric Transport Team at The Bristol-Myers Squibb Children's Hospital at Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital is comprised of specially-trained physicians, advanced practice nurses, registered nurses, respiratory therapists and EMTs, who are equipped to manage the unique needs of children and their families, 24-hours-a-day, 7-days-a-week.

- Dedicated nurses to answer and expedite all referrals
- Physicians are available to assist with pre-transfer management as needed
