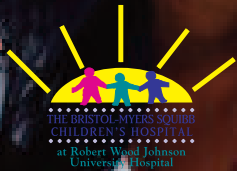

Conditions Treated

- Abnormal development of the reproductive structures
- Contraception (patch, pill, ring)
- Early or delayed puberty
- Endometriosis/ Endometriomas
- Labial adhesions
- Lichen sclerosus
- Medical uses of hormonal contraceptives (pill)
- Menstrual problems
- Menstrual suppression (eliminate / minimize periods)
- Ovarian cysts
- Pelvic Inflammatory Disease
- Pelvic Pain/Masses
- Polycystic ovary syndrome (PCOS)
- Sexually transmitted infections (STIs)
- Torsion of the ovary
- Trauma to the genitalia
- Uterine bleeding (abnormal)
- Vaginal agenesis
- Vaginal stenosis
- Vulvodynia
- Vulvar ulcers or lesions
- Vulvovaginitis

The Adolescent Gynecology Program provides state-of-the-art evaluation and treatment modalities including:

- Vaginal irrigation
- Vaginoscopy
- Harmonic scalpel
- Minimally invasive surgery (laparoscopy, hysteroscopy, microlaparoscopy)
- Complex genitourinary reconstructive surgery
- Vaginal reconstruction (surgical creation of neovagina, vaginal septum resection)
 - Skin graft (neovagina)
 - Buccal graft (vaginal reconstruction)
 - Laparoscopic assisted vaginoplasty
