### Driving Directions

**1 Robert Wood Johnson Place, New Brunswick, NJ 08901**

**From New Jersey Turnpike:** Take Exit 9 (New Brunswick) and proceed on Route 18 North about two miles to Route 27 South—Princeton, to the fourth traffic light (by the railroad station). Turn right onto Easton Avenue; make a left at the next light onto Somerset Street. Proceed one block to the intersection of Little Albany on the left. Make a sharp left onto Little Albany and parking deck is on the right.

**From Garden State Parkway (From Points North):** Exit at Route 1 South (Exit 130). Proceed about nine miles to Route 18 North to Route 27 South—Princeton, to the fourth traffic light (by the railroad station). Turn right onto Easton Avenue; make a left at the next light onto Somerset Street. Proceed one block to the intersection of Little Albany on the left. Make a sharp left onto Little Albany and parking deck is on the right.

**From Garden State Parkway (From Points South):** Exit onto New Jersey Turnpike South. Take Exit 9 (New Brunswick) and proceed on Route 18 North about two miles to Route 27 South—Princeton, to the fourth traffic light (by the railroad station). Turn right onto Easton Avenue; make a left at the next light onto Somerset Street. Proceed one block to the intersection of Little Albany on the left. Make a sharp left onto Little Albany and parking deck is on the right.

**From Route 287:** Exit onto Route 527 (New Brunswick Exit). Follow Route 527 (Easton Avenue) for about six miles until you see a railroad overpass. Just before the overpass, make a right onto Little Albany Street. Proceed to the hospital, on your left.

**From Route 1:** Take Route 18 North to Route 27 South—Princeton, to the fourth traffic light (by the railroad station). Turn right onto Easton Avenue; make a left at the next light onto Somerset Street. Proceed one block to the intersection of Little Albany on the left. Make a sharp left onto Little Albany and parking deck is on the right.

**From Route 18:** Exit onto Route 27 South-Princeton, to the fourth traffic light (by the railroad station). Turn right onto Easton Avenue; make a left at the next light onto Somerset Street. Proceed one block to the intersection of Little Albany on the left. Make a sharp left onto Little Albany and parking deck is on the right.

**From Route 9:** Exit onto Route 18 North to Route 27 South—Princeton, to the fourth traffic light (by the railroad station). Turn right onto Easton Avenue, make a left at the next light onto Somerset Street. Proceed one block to the intersection of Little Albany on the left. Make a sharp left onto Little Albany and parking deck is on the right.



## Parking

RWJ offers a variety of parking options for our visitors and guests. Parking validation is available at the Information Desk to receive the \$3 per day parking fee.

Patients are encouraged to use the valet parking service available Monday through Friday from 5:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. in front of the main hospital.

We also offer options in a variety of self-pay parking decks, including the University Deck which is located adjacent to the facility and is available 24-hours-a-day, seven-days-a-week.

Our self-pay Plum Street parking deck (located on Plum Street) is available to patients, visitors and guests 24-hours-a-day, seven-days-a-week.

The Paterson Street deck (located on Paterson Street) and across from the Clinical Academic Building is available to patients, visitors and guests 24-hours-a-day, seven-days-a-week.
