

Comprehensive Care for Joint Replacement (CJR)

RWJ University Hospital Somerset is participating in a Medicare initiative called the Comprehensive Care for Joint Replacement (CJR) model. The CJR model aims to promote quality and financial accountability for care surrounding lower-extremity joint replacement (LEJR) procedures, commonly referred to as hip and knee replacements and/or other major leg procedures.

RWJ University Hospital Somerset is working closely with the doctors and other health care providers and suppliers who will care for you during and following your hospital stay and extending through the recovery period. By working together, your health care providers and suppliers are planning more efficient, high quality care as you undergo treatment. Medicare will monitor your care to ensure you and others are receiving high quality care.

RWJ University Hospital Somerset has entered into financial arrangements with collaborating health care providers and suppliers who are engaged in care redesign with the hospital and who may furnish health care services to you during your episode of care. Under these agreements, RWJ University Hospital Somerset may share payments received from Medicare as a result of reduced episode spending and hospital internal cost savings with collaborating providers and suppliers.
