Explanation of Application Requirements (by number)

1. Completion of the Union College application and admission process

- a. All applicants to Trinitas School of Nursing must be current Union College students, therefore completion of the Union College application and admission process is required to apply to Trinitas School of Nursing.
- b. Visit www.ucc.edu/admissions/ for information regarding the Union College admission process

2. Recommendation of developmental course work

- a. It is recommended to speak to Academic Advising to determine whether it is appropriate to register for developmental coursework in Math and English. They can be contacted at nursing@ucc.edu.
- 3. The following co-requisite courses must be reflected on the applicants unofficial Union College transcript; as completed, transferred, currently enrolled, or registered for at Union College.
 - a. Co-requisite courses are recommended to be taken before NURE 105, if possible. Must be completed prior to starting the second TSON course.
 - BIO 105
 - PSY 101
 - ENG 101 or 112 (if ESL)
 - b. A minimum grade of C is required in all Science courses and all courses transferred to Union College.

4. Establish a Union College GPA of 2.5 or higher or high school GPA of 2.5* or higher

- a. A minimum Union College GPA of 2.5 is required for admission.
 - The GPA must be established at Union College or
 - A high school GPA will be considered for applicants who graduated high school within a year of application submission.
- b. Students who have transferred in all their co-requisite courses will have a GPA of 0.00. Your application will be reviewed considering all eligibility requirements have been met.
- c. The maximum number of transfer credits is 33.
 - All college transcripts must be evaluated by Academic Advising. The transferred courses must be reflected on your current Union County College unofficial transcript. Be sure to review the transcript <u>before</u> submitting your application form.

5. Attendance at a Trinitas School of Nursing Information Session

- a. Attendance at a Trinitas School of Nursing Information Session is required within 12 months <u>prior</u> to submitting your application.
- b. Attach email receipt of attendance as a PDF with your application.

6. Minimum TEAS score of 55%

 a. All prospective students are responsible for reviewing and understanding the TEAS Assessment information located on the Trinitas School of Nursing website at https://www.rwjbh.org/documents/trinitas-nursing/Follow-this-link-for-all-information-for-the-TEAS-exam.pdf.

Requirements for Complete Application

1. Current Unofficial Union College Transcript

- a. Must be printed from webservices with all required courses reflected.
- b. This is the only college transcript accepted.
- c. All required courses that have been taken at another institution must be transferred in <u>prior</u> to applying and reflected on unofficial Union College transcript.
- 2. Receipt from Trinitas School of Nursing Information Session
- 3. TEAS Assessment Results
 - a. The TEAS transcript must be electronically transferred to Trinitas School of Nursing through ATI directly prior to the application deadline.
 - b. Please contact ATI directly regarding any questions about the transcript at 800.667.7531.
- 4. Official High School Transcript, if applicable
 - a. Only applies to applicants who have graduated high school within the last 12 months.

- All supporting documents must be attached as PDF attachments.
- Applications submitted through any other mode will not be accepted or responded to.
- Applications must be sent through your Union College email address.
- Once your application is reviewed, you will receive an email to confirm receipt to your owl email address.
