Explanation of Application Requirements (by number)

1. Completion of the Union College application and admission process

- a. All applicants to Trinitas School of Nursing must be current Union College students, therefore completion of the Union College application and admission process is required to apply to Trinitas School of Nursing.

2. The following pre-requisite courses must be reflected on the applicants unofficial Union College transcript as transferred or completed.

- BIO 105, BIO 106, BIO 108
- ENG 101 or 112 (if ESL), ENG 102
- PSY 101, PSY 204, SOC 101
- Two Humanities courses (6 credits)
- a. A minimum grade of C is required in all Science courses and all courses transferred to Union College.

3. Establish a Union College GPA of 2.5 or higher

- a. A minimum Union College GPA of 2.5 is required for admission.
 - A GPA must be established at Union College
- b. The maximum number of transfer credits is 33.
 - All college transcripts must be evaluated by Academic Advising. The transferred courses must be reflected on your current Union College unofficial transcript. Be sure to review the transcript <u>before</u> submitting your application form.

4. Attendance at a Trinitas School of Nursing Information Session

- a. Attendance at a Trinitas School of Nursing Information Session is required within 12 months <u>prior to</u> submitting your application.
- b. Attach email receipt of attendance as a PDF with your application.
- 5. You must have an unencumbered current LPN license from any state.

6. Minimum TEAS score of 55%

Requirements for Complete Application

- 1. Current Unofficial Union College Transcript
 - a. Must be printed from webservices with all required courses reflected.
 - b. This is the only college transcript accepted.
 - All required courses that have been taken at another institution must be transferred in <u>prior</u> to applying and be reflected on Unofficial Union College Transcript.
- 2. Receipt from Trinitas School of Nursing Information Session.
- 3. Copy of current unencumbered LPN License.
- 4. TEAS Assessment Results
 - a. The TEAS transcript must be electronically transferred to Trinitas School of Nursing directly by ATI prior to application deadline.
 - b. Please contact ATI directly for any questions regarding the transcript at 800.667.7531.

- Applications submitted through any other mode <u>will not be accepted</u> or responded to.
