



Enrollment Process for Trinitas School of Nursing and Kean University

1. Apply to Kean University:
 - a. Students applying through the Trinitas/Kean partnership will contact the Kean Nursing department or transfer@kean.edu for the current application fee waiver promo code
 - b. Submit official transcripts from every college and post-secondary institutions attended
 - c. Preferred GPA: 2.5
 - d. Students are admitted as intended Nursing major
 - e. Successful completion of NURE 130 OR 211 Nursing Trends and Concepts is required to be admitted
2. Acceptance
 - a. Students receive notification email that their transfer credit evaluation is available on KeanWise
 - b. Visit the accepted students page: www.kean.edu/accepted to follow the next steps:
 - i. Pay the tuition deposit
 - ii. Students will be notified by email when their transfer credit evaluation is complete
 - iii. Connect with the academic advisor
 - iv. Register for classes
 - c. Students email nursing@kean.edu to schedule advisement, which includes:
 - i. Graduation plan
 - ii. Course scheduling
 - iii. Reminder to submit final transcript upon the completion of any course taken outside of Kean University
 - d. Each of the Parties shall bill and collect the tuition and fees for those courses offered within their respective institutions in accordance with the respective (Kean, Trinitas and Union) tuition and payment policies. Financial aid for courses offered by Kean will be administered by Kean's Financial Aid Office and Union County College courses requiring financial aid will be administered through Union County College.
3. Enrollment
 - a. See curriculum map for details related to courses available prior to graduating from Trinitas and for the courses required for the BSN
 - b. Dual enrolled students can take the following courses before graduating from Trinitas:
 - i. NURS 3000 Conceptual Foundations in Nursing
 - ii. NURS 3015 Health Assessment
 - iii. NURS 3020 Foundations of Transcultural Care
 - iv. NURS 3030 Issues in Professional Nursing Practice
 - v. NURS 3400 Health Information Literacy and Technology
 - c. After graduation, NCLEX, and RN licensure, students will complete the following courses to complete the BSN
 - i. NURS 4020 Population Focused Nursing in the Community

- ii. NURS 4200 Research and Evidence-Based Practice in Nursing
- iii. NURS 4400 Prof. Nursing Leadership and Innovation
- iv. NURS 4500 Transition to Professional Nursing Practice

d. Declaring Major

- i. Upon receiving the RN license, students must contact their advisor or the Kean School of Nursing to complete the Change of Major form to declare
- ii. Students will need to complete an attestation form to acknowledge their receipt of policies and procedures related to the health clearance and criminal background check requirements
- iii. Students need to declare their major in order to register for senior-level Nursing courses
- iv. Students that are academically dismissed from the Trinitas School of Nursing must notify Kean University School of Nursing because they will no longer be able to make progress toward their BSN
