



Trinitas School of Nursing Scholarship Application Packet

Important Scholarship Eligibility Information (please read carefully):

- A complete Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and a Union College Scholarship Application must be on file with the Union College Financial Aid Office to be eligible for a Trinitas School of Nursing Scholarship.
- A minimum 3.0 Union College grade point average (GPA) is required to be eligible for a Trinitas School of Nursing Scholarship.
- A minimum 3.25 Union College GPA is required to be eligible for a Kellogg Scholarship.
- Students who have failed a Trinitas School of Nursing course (a NURE course) are not eligible for a Trinitas School of Nursing Scholarship.
- Some Trinitas School of Nursing scholarships require United States citizenship as an eligibility requirement. Permanent residents and eligible non-citizens may be eligible for select Trinitas School of Nursing scholarships.
- Students entering their first clinical course, although eligible, receive scholarship consideration after distribution of upper classman scholarships.
- Students must be a currently registered Trinitas School of Nursing student and have met all required clinical requirements to be awarded Trinitas School of Nursing scholarship.

Scholarship Application Submission Instructions:

- A copy of your current **unofficial Union College transcript** downloaded from webservices, must be attached to your Scholarship Application.
- A copy of dated receipt that Union College scholarship and FAFSA application applied for must be attached.
- Applicants are required to submit a Trinitas School of Nursing Scholarship Application each academic semester by the specified deadlines:
 - **July 15th for Fall semester applicants**
 - **January 15th for Spring semester applicants**
- Applications are only accepted via e-mail to trinitas@ucc.edu.

Scholarship Decision Information:

- All applicants will be advised of status of scholarship decisions by email to your OWL email address.

Scholarship Acceptance:

- Each scholarship has minimum acceptance requirements that must be followed for scholarship to be completed.
- All scholarships require a thank you letter addressed to the foundation

Available Trinitas School of Nursing Scholarships:

- **JC Kellogg Foundation Scholarship:**
 - Awarded on a competitive basis each semester to students who have completed NURE 132 or NURE 250
 - Must be a U.S Citizen or permanent resident
 - Minimum 3.25 Union College GPA required
- **Switzer Foundation Scholarship:**
 - Minimum 3.0 Union College GPA required
 - Awarded to female students only
 - US citizenship required
 - Legal residency within 50 miles of New York City required
 - Not awarded to students who have earned a bachelor's degree
 - Must demonstrate a financial need
- **Trinitas Professional Education Assistance Program Scholarship:**
 - Minimum 3.0 Union College GPA required
 - Awarded to students who demonstrate academic excellence and/or a financial need
- **Hetzel Family Scholarship:**
 - Awarded each semester to one male and one female student
 - Minimum 3.0 Union College GPA required
 - Financial need may be considered
 - Eligible students will have completed NURE 131 or NURE 250
- **Summit Area Public Foundation's Memorial Fund Scholarship:**
 - Minimum 3.0 Union College GPA required
 - Awarded based on academic performance
 - Financial need may be considered
- **Janice B. Pasko Memorial Scholarship:**
 - Minimum 3.0 Union College GPA required
 - Awarded to Generic Track students only
 - Must show a documented financial need
 - Must show evidence of being a caring individual
