Our Comprehensive Breast Program Includes:

Breast Imaging:

Digital Screening & Diagnostic Mammography

Digitally enhanced breast images have outstanding clarity and contrast, leading to a quick diagnosis and quality patient care.

· Breast Ultrasound

A non-invasive procedure in which high frequency sound waves are painlessly projected into the breast and the pattern of echoes is interpreted by a dedicated Radiologist.

Breast MRI

Breast MRI (Magnetic Resonance Imaging) is a non-invasive procedure that allows doctors to look inside the breast to see the soft tissue, without having to do surgery or flatten the breast (as in a mammogram).

• Fine Needle Aspiration

In this procedure a thin needle is inserted into a mass. Fluid or cells are extracted from a suspicious mass.

Cyst Aspiration

A procedure where the doctor uses a small needle to drain fluid from a cyst.

• Ultrasound Guided Tissue Core Biopsy

This procedure is used when a mass is visualized on ultrasound and determined to be solid. The Radiologist is guided by ultrasound and takes samples of the mass using a needle.

• Stereotactic (X-Ray) Guided Tissue Biopsy

This procedure uses a needle to extract tissue samples from an abnormality seen on a mammogram. Guided by computer images, and using local anesthesia, the Radiologist can take a sample of the abnormality.

• Breast Needle Localization

A simple procedure where a wire is inserted to mark the exact position of an abnormality in the breast.

Sentinel Node Injection

Sentinel node biopsy involves injecting a radioactive tracer and/or blue dye into and around the tumor. Once located, the sentinel node is removed through a small incision and sent to the laboratory for diagnosis.

Computer-Assisted Detection (CAD)

CAD uses the X-ray image taken in a mammogram and creates a digital image. The computer then scans the image and marks suspicious looking areas. Those areas can be studied by a radiologist, who can then decide if a biopsy or further evaluation is needed.
